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Correction: Theoretical accuracy for indirect predictions based on SNP effects from single-step GBLUP

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After publication of this work [1], we noticed that there was an error in Eqs. (14) to (19) presented on page 4 of the paper, where we refer to the term $var(\hat{a})$ as the

prediction error covariance (PEC) of SNP effects which is not correct.

The correct equations should be:

$$\operatorname{var}(\widehat{\mathbf{a}}) = (1 - \alpha)b \frac{1}{2 \sum p_i (1 - p_i)} \mathbf{Z}' \mathbf{G}^{-1} \left(\mathbf{G} \sigma_{\mathbf{u}}^2 - \mathbf{C}^{\mathbf{u}_2 \mathbf{u}_2} \right) \mathbf{G}^{-1} \mathbf{Z} \frac{1}{2 \sum p_i (1 - p_i)} b(1 - \alpha). \tag{17}$$

Therefore,

$$var(\widehat{\mathbf{a}}) = (1 - \alpha)b \frac{1}{2\sum p_i(1 - p_i)} (\mathbf{Z}'\mathbf{G}^{-1}\mathbf{Z}\sigma_{\mathbf{u}}^2 - \mathbf{Z}'\mathbf{G}^{-1}\mathbf{C}^{\mathbf{u}_2\mathbf{u}_2}\mathbf{G}^{-1}\mathbf{Z}) \frac{1}{2\sum p_i(1 - p_i)} b(1 - \alpha).$$

Please note that the equations are correctly programmed in the software used for analyses, and the corrections above do not affect the end results presented in the manuscript.

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
